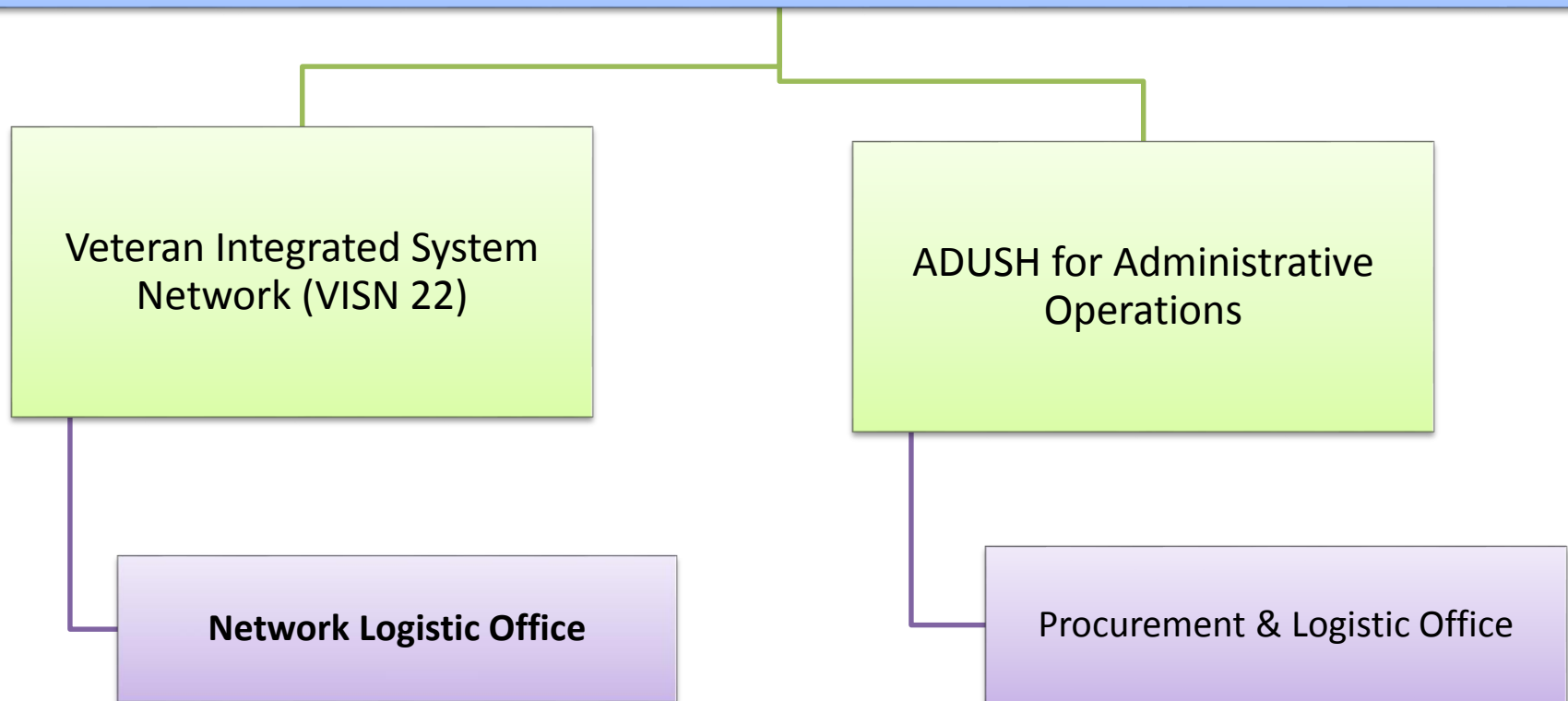

Acquisitions and Contractual Authority

Acquisitions and contractual commitments can only be made by Government officials having expressed authority to enter into such agreements on behalf of the United States Government. The **ONLY** Government officials with such authority are Warranted Contracting Officials. Any discussions of contractual requirements do not constitute contractual direction or authorization of any kind. Future contractual directions, if **ANY**, shall **ONLY** come from the cognizant Department of Veterans Affairs Warranted Contracting Officer.

Mandatory/Priority Sources

VA Mandatory Prime Vendors

MCKESSON: The Pharmaceutical Prime Vendor is an innovative contract method used to provide drugs and other pharmaceuticals to our nation's and Veterans and other federal Government agencies.

CARDINAL HEALTH 200: The program is mandatory for all VA medical centers and currently consists of seven prime vendor contracts. The new generation of Prime Vendors will consist of an approved catalog of items that will eliminate any distribution fee.

US FOODS: The Subsistence Prime Vendor (SPV) includes all food and foodservice supplies except for fresh bread, fresh milk, and fresh produce for just-in-time deliveries to all VA Medical Centers and eligible OGAs.

Various Contracts: The Prosthetics contract listing is to obtain uniform and quality products at lower than local contract and open market prices. These contracts insure availability and consistency of products for nationwide usage and to obtain volume-based, committed use pricing.
