Acquisitions and Contractual Authority

- Acquisitions and contractual commitments can only be made by Government officials having expressed authority to enter into such agreements on behalf of the United States Government. The ONLY Government officials with such authority are Warranted Contracting Officials. Any discussions of contractual requirements do not constitute contractual direction or authorization of any kind. Future contractual directions, if ANY, shall ONLY come from the Department of Veterans Affairs Warranted Contracting Officer.

Construction Team	Construction & Architectural Engineering (AE) Services
General Services Team	Services contracts except for construction & AE
Medical Services Team	Professional Medical Services (Physicians, Nurses, Technicians)
Supply Team	Equipment & Supplies, Bread & Milk, Software Licenses, Furniture
Specialty Team	Unique contracting (Real Estate Leases, Selling Agreements, Utilities, Prosthetics)
Purchase Card Program	Streamlined approach to purchasing supplies/services under micro-purchase threshold (currently \$3,500)
Consolidated Mail Outpatient Pharmacy (CMOP)	High volume mail delivery of medications

- Full & Open Competition (Open to all vendors)
